Hotel

We have reserved a block of hotel rooms at the

The hotel is located in the city center, right across from the train station. We will book a room including breakfast for you for the **price of 56 EUR/person/night**, if you indicate on the registration form that you would like to stay there.

During the meeting we will arrange a free **taxi shuttle** between the hotel and the HWK. Detailed information on this service and departure times will be provided in our email with the confirmation of your registration closer to the date of the conference.

Meals

All meals indicated on the program/registration form will be provided at the HWK free of charge. Please make sure to indicate meal preferences (vegetarian...) on the registration form.

Internet connection at HWK

WLAN is available for all participants everywhere on campus. Information on passwords will be posted in the hall upon arrival. A desktop computer with internet connection is available in the library.

Poster Boards and Presentation Services at HWK

Poster boards are 1,40m high and 1,18m broad, i.e. A0 portrait format posters fit. Pins for mounting the posters will be provided.

Presentations can be projected from a PC desktop computer or from your own laptop (HDMI, USB-C). A laser pointer/remote control and MAC adapters are available (no support for VGA ports!). A good sound system also allows the presentation of sound files. Please do not forget plug adapters for German electrical outlets (220V/50 Hz AC) if you plan on using the power supply! Paper and electronic flip charts are also available. If you would like to use unusual presentation equipment, please contact us before your arrival so that we can make arrangements ahead of time!

Using our hybrid conference system allows a seamless participation on site and remotely. Speakers on campus project their presentation on the screen in the lecture hall. In parallel, the presentation is streamed into the Zoom meeting for remote attendees. Speakers in the Zoom meeting share their screen as usual which is also shown in the lecture hall. During the discussion, the Zoom window is projected on the screen, and participants are able to interact visually and acoustically both ways thanks to a ceiling microphone controlling the camera direction.

We will send you the access information for the zoom meeting ahead of time in case you would like to participate remotely.

Covid-Regulations & your safety on campus

Covid-regulations are subject to change. We will keep you posted and send you the latest regulations right before the meeting, including local opportunities for Corona-testing.

Please note that **all participants must present the following proofs upon arrival:**

- full vaccination (> 14 days after the last jab) OR recovery from a Covid-19 infection (positive test older than 28 days and less than 6 months ago)

AND in **addition a negative current PCR or Antigen test** not older than 24 hours upon arrival (no self-test!)

Your contact data will be collected and stored for a period of up to 4 weeks so that you can be notified in case of a Corona infection amongst the participants (see the regulations for [data protection](#) mentioned below).

For your safety and out of responsibility for our fellows and staff members, the following rules apply:

- Please keep a distance of at least 1,5 metres to other persons.
- Masks must be worn inside all buildings, including in the lecture hall during the workshop. Masks may only be taken off by the current speaker and by participants while eating.
- Please wash/ disinfect your hands frequently.
- Regular airing of the rooms, particularly the lecture hall, must be followed (at least once an hour).
- Three mobile air filters are provided in the lecture hall and must be kept running throughout the meeting.

Privacy/ data protection
